## To whom it may concern:

This memorandum is intended to provide evidence that the above-mentioned project will benefit a disadvantaged community. The format of this letter generally follows guidance received from the Indiana Finance Authority Website.

Introduction: The study area for this report focuses on the Bean Blossom Creek watershed, an area that has struggled with water quality issues and poor septic system functionality for many years. This watershed falls under the jurisdiction of the Brown County Regional Sewer District (BCRSD), which has contracted with BLN to design and construct a series of low-pressure sewers and lift stations as a replacement for the study area's failing septic systems. Small lot sizes and hilly topography have restricted the ability for residents to expand and improve their existing onsite waste disposal systems, leading to the design of this project. Gravity sewers have been deemed economically and technically infeasible due to topographic constraints, leaving low-pressure sewers as the ideal choice for a collection system. In terms of wastewater treatment, there have been discussions with neighboring Helmsburg RSD about upgrading their existing plant to accept wastewater flows from this planned collection system. If these discussions do not prove effective, BCRSD has also explored the alternative of constructing a new treatment plant along State Road 45 near Needmore and Trevlac.

<u>Census Tracts Impacted:</u> Brown County tracts 9747 and 9748 and Monroe County tract 14.04 are the impacted census tracts for the proposed project. The impacts will include new low pressure sewer main installation and construction of multiple new lift stations. An average median household income for these three census tracts, weighted by proposed customers in each tract, is \$66,902. Median household income data for each individual tract is below in the Summary Table.

<u>Service Area Overlap:</u> Brown County RSD currently has no wastewater collection and treatment system. When the proposed project is complete, it will extend generally along State Road 45 from



northeastern Monroe County to north central Brown County. The populated areas of Needmore, Trevlac, and Beanblossom are the primary areas to be served by the proposed low pressure sewer, with future extensions to pick up additional customers highly likely. Discussions are ongoing with Helmsburg RSD regarding the use of their existing treatment plant for the wastewater flows generated by this proposed project. Additional coordination is being undertaken between Brown County RSD and Monroe County officials.
