- : I am working on getting my asset management report and bridge asset management done for Indiana LTAP (Local Technical Assistance Program)
- : We are doing our daily tasks, mowing, grading, ditching, pothole patching, weed maintenance around guardrails, bridges and signs
- : We are still preparing our snow equipment and our guys to get ready for this season
- : We have installed our bridge signs to be compliant with the federal mandate
- : We have been replacing street signs that have been missing from theft and accidents
- : We have asphalt patched several road cuts from installing culvert pipes
- : We have replaced two culvert pipes under Green Valley Rd due to deterioration
- : We have been installing driveway culverts as residents request and pay
- : We have sold a piece of equipment called Total Patcher. This equipment had not been used in years and was out of commission. We got an estimate to fix this for about \$12,000. We sold it back to the original place we purchased from for \$15,000. We are also going to sell the silo tank back to them as well after we get it cleaned out.
- : We are purchasing a piece of equipment with money from the sell for our asphalt hot box called an Infrared heater
- : We are having AAA Striping repair two sections of double yellow lines on Helmsburg Rd. Right now, they are unsafe as the lines are uneven
