## Brown County Highway Department Monthly Update as of November 18<sup>th</sup>

- : We have completed our 2024 asset management plan and our 2024 bridge asset management plan. I have submitted both plans to LTAP and they have been approved.
- : We are doing our daily tasks, mowing, grading, ditching, pothole patching, weed maintenance around guardrails, bridges and signs. Tree removal
- : Our snowplow equipment is almost all up and running
- : We are still replacing street signs that have been missing from theft and damaged
- : We are working on getting guard rails replaced from an accident at the Helmsburg and Oak Grove intersection
- : We have fixed several guard rails that have been broken or missing
- : We have been installing driveway culverts as residents request and pay
- : We have received our bridge package for a small structure on Hamilton Creek Rd. Plans are to start construction beginning of December
- : Our bridge crew has been doing maintenance on our bridges. Fixing broken welds on the grated decks
- : We have had AAA Striping repair two sections of double yellow lines on Helmsburg Rd.
- : We are working with contractors to get several asphalt base repair areas fixed on multiple roads.
- : We are working with contractors to get a concrete floor in our truck storage barn.
