## Brown County Highway Department Monthly Update as of December 2<sup>nd</sup>

- : We are starting our bridge replacement project on Hamilton Creek Rd. this week. We hope to have it completed within a week. Weather permitting
- : We are doing our daily tasks, mowing, grading, ditching, pothole patching, working on bridges and signs, tree removal from fallen trees
- : We have had trucks out on two different occasions so far putting salt/sand mix on the roads for snow and ice
- : We are still replacing street signs that have been missing from theft and damaged
- : The guard rails on Helmsburg Rd and Oak Grove have been repaired from an accident. This was no cost to the county.
- : We have been installing driveway culverts as residents request and pay
- : We have installed culverts under the road on Reed Hollow Rd, Daugherty Rd, Salmeron Rd, Green Valley Rd. These were replaced from damage or just old rusted out.
- : Our bridge crew has been doing maintenance on our bridges. Fixing broken welds on the grated decks
- : Weather permitting, we will have base repairs fixed on Salt Creek Rd. Sweetwater Trail, Bellsville Pike, Poplar Grove Rd.
- : We are working on getting a NOFA application submitted for a federal opportunity to replace bridge #43 on Elkinsville Rd.
- : We have installed dangerous intersection signs and yellow flashing lights on Helmsburg Rd at the intersection with Oak Grove Rd.
