Brown County Highway Department Monthly Update for December 18th

- : We have completed the first bridge replacement on Hamilton Creek. We were able to reuse the existing concrete abutments. We put in new galvanized coated beams with a new grated deck. This was completed in-house by our Bridge crew.
- : We have started on our 2nd bridge structure replacement on Hamilton Creek Rd. We are tearing out the existing bridge structure and replacing it with a new 8' diameter 30' long metal culvert pipe
- : We are doing our daily tasks, mowing, grading, ditching, pothole patching, working on bridges and signs, chipping brush, tree removal from fallen trees
- : We have been washing, servicing and fixing our equipment as needed (daily)
- : We have been salting the roads as needed from snow and ice
- : We are working on new updated bridge signs as needed
- : We have been hauling stone in and out as needed
- : We have had asphalt base repairs fixed on Salt Creek Rd. Sweetwater Trail, Bellsville Pike, Poplar Grove Rd. Mt Moriah. These were contracted out with the winning bid to JL Hardin Paving
- : I have submitted a Federal Grant application for Elkinsville Bridge #43. We will find out around February in 2025 if Brown County was selected for this grant. This is an 80-20 split. Construction would be in 2030
- : Our Highway building has all new entrance signs now. Two of them were completed by the local school
- : We have completed our 2024 call 1 CCMG grant close out.
